Age Categories

Even though the titles are being conducted in 2018, they are the 2019 Championships and therefore the Under 19 categories are open to cyclists who turn 17 or 18 years of age in 2019 (ie cyclists born in 2001 and 2002).

Entry Criteria

The Championships are open to National teams, UCI registered teams, Australian State or Institute teams, NZ centre teams, club teams and individual entries. All entrants must be a member of a National Federation in the Oceania region of the UCI. Individual entries will require the endorsement of their State Coach before their entry is accepted.

Licenses

Riders are permitted to race on their 2018 or 2019 domestic licence. A rider's UCI code will be required. This is to be provided at the time of registration.

Meetings and Registration

The managers/riders meeting will be held at 3.00pm on Tuesday 9 October 2018 in the VIP room upstairs at the Super-Drome. All team managers/independent riders are required to attend this meeting after which registration for the event will take place. Registration will be held between 4.00pm and 5.00pm.

Team managers are reminded of the following for the above meetings:

- Managers are to have the licences of all competing cyclists & UCI Codes. All licences must be signed by the holder. If a manager cannot produce a specific licence he must have either a receipt or a letter of explanation from the National/State body concerned and the rider's UCI Code
- Managers must produce a sample of the clothing their cyclists will be wearing
- All Australian competitors and officials must be registered with CA
- All international team members and officials must be registered with a UCI affiliated Federation
- All riders need to have their bikes inspected, riders who may fall outside the normal measurements note re: morphological rule should be raised at permanence.

Clothing

Australian riders to compete in registered club, team or state clothing.

Note: if selected in an Australian Team for the Team Pursuit, Team Sprint or Madison, riders will be required to wear Australian team clothing, which they may need to purchase, unless they already have an Australian skinsuit.

Training

The velodrome will be available for training from Monday 8 October and Tuesday 9 October. A training schedule will be circulated after entries close.

Storage

Teams will be allocated equipment storage for boxes under the track. Each team must bring their own padlock with cables to secure bikes. Bikes will remain in Track Centre overnight. It's the team's responsibility to secure bikes.

Travel Arrangements

All athletes will be responsible for their own arrangements and accommodation. We wish those who compete at the Championships all the best for a successful event.

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
