



2019 Oceania BMX Continental Championships

Saturday 19 January 2019 - UCI CC Class - Event Guidelines



BMX New Zealand is proud to present the 2019 Oceania BMX Continental Championships. This event will be only the third event in recent times held in New Zealand, this time at the Te Awamutu BMX Club track.

The Event will be held in conjunction with the Te Awamutu Rangi Merito Memorial meeting, where the results from the Saturday will be added to the racing on Sunday for an overall weekend result.

The following guidelines will detail the Oceania event format & all requirement for entry. The Rangi Merito Memorial will have a separate flyer, but entry is below.

EVENT LOCATION:

Venue - Te Awamutu BMX Club Track Facility.

Address - Castleton Park, Park Road, Te Awamutu, Waikato Region

ENTRIES CLOSE:

Sunday, 9 December 2018.

NO Late Entries will be accepted.

ENTRY FEES:

The Challenge Class entry fee covers both Saturday Oceania's & the Sunday Rangi Merito Memorial events.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

The Challenge Class entry fee covers both Saturday Oceania's & the Sunday Rangi Merito Memorial events.

No entry will be taken on day of event.

Entry is complete only when payment is confirmed.

BMXNZ reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.

Riders must have a valid BMXA licence & for have adequate racing insurance cover, then apply for a BMXNZ licence online at www.bmxnz.co.nz > EVENTS > International licence

Entry & payment via std online system with your BMXNZ licence number.

NUMBER PLATES:

Number plates will be issued by BMXNZ to club/team managers. Offshore rider may individually collect plates.

Riders holding a 2018 Oceania ranking of 1-8 or 2018 World ranking of 1-8 may choose to enter the meeting using this ranking.

TRANSPONDERS:

Transponders will be used at this event (except 6& under Sprockets). Please update your Online Profile with your transponder number BEFORE the entries close - <https://nzbmx.club/riderportal>

There will be NO rental transponders by BMXNZ—other third parties may have rental transponders.

Transponder Registration. All transponders will need to be registered onsite prior to racing. This will be done at the check point near the Admin hut. This process can be done at anytime during the Friday practice times or 8-10am Saturday morning.

It is the entrants responsibility to check that their transponder is working prior to practice. A non functioning transponder at race time will result in a DNS.

Championship - Scrambled motos then transfer to finals
Challenge Classes as per BMXNZ Rule Book

MINIMUM CLASS SIZE

6 riders constitute a class. Class sizes will be determined after the close of entries for trophy allocation purposes.

RACING FORMAT

Championship /Challenge 20" & Cruiser Classes:

3 motos for all classes, with finals and transfer per UCI rules, as required using the following matrix:

8 or less riders:	3 motos points aggregated
9 or more riders:	3 motos then;
9-16 riders:	to deadman final
17-32 riders:	to deadman semis & deadman final
33-64 riders:	to deadman quarters, deadman semis & deadman final
65-80 riders:	to deadman eighths, deadman quarters, deadman semis & deadman final

RACING FORMAT NOTES:

In case of disruption or adverse weather, moto format may be changed, at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire.

TIED POSITIONS:

All tied positions will be separated by Countback. No run-offs will be held.

PRIZE GIVING:

Prize giving trackside 30 minutes after racing finishes

AWARDS & TROPHY ALLOCATION:

Classes with 8 riders or less: Trophies and Presentation Plates to 3rd place

Classes with 9 riders: Trophies to 3rd place and Presentation Plates to 7th place

Classes with 10 riders or more: Trophies to 3rd place and Presentation Plates to 8th place

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS PURSE PAYMENTS:

Purse of \$5000.00 will be proportionally split between the male and female classes based on number of entries and then pay out to 8th place.

SCRUTINEERING:

Officials will randomly check riders before and during the event, including all official practice and warm up sessions when safety gear and number plates must be worn. It is recommended that clubs & managers scrutineer all bikes prior to the event.

EVENT ONLINE ENTRY PROCESS:

BMXNZ have issued the link below to the **INDIVIDUAL ONLINE ENTRY** site.

All riders wishing to enter the event must **ENTER THEMSELVES**. Supply all detail as requested, check entry detail & confirm entry.

PAYMENT will follow the entry process. Either via credit card on the site provided or direct transfer via Poli-Pay to the detail supplied online.

FINAL entry lists will be sorted by CLUB(NZ) or COUNTRY. NZ Club Team Managers to organise the collection of race plates at the event. International Rider to collect individually.

OCEANIA BMX CHAMPIONSHIPS EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

UCI, OCC, CNZ, BMXNZ, The Waikato Region & Te Awamutu BMX Club will comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 2015 by committing to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all riders, families and visitors to the BMX Event facility. It is the sports policy to "make every practical and reasonable effort to protect all visitors, to prevent accidents or serious harm injuries and promote safety and welfare of all persons while on the event facility".

UCI, OCC, CNZ, BMXNZ, The Waikato Region & Te Awamutu BMX Club will take all possible steps to list and evaluate hazards and to determine solutions to eliminate or minimise those hazards as part of the Risk Management Plan (RMP), to meet the sports policy noted above.

BMX Racing is an action sport & inherently has risks that are accepted as part of sport. All known risks are noted in the BMXNZ Major Meeting RMP & this is available onsite during the event. Parties wanting to assess the RMP prior to entry must contact the club for detail. Entry to this event confirms an understanding of the risks of the sport as noted in the RMP. In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book.

Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc, OCC is the Oceania Cycling Confederation, CNZ is Cycling New Zealand & UCI is the Union Cycliste Internationale.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.

WRSCS RACE FORMAT: 3 moto, 3 final format

10 or more riders 3 Moto's top 8 to final – 3 finals, points over

Consolation finals -3 finals, points over to determine points for series.

9 or less riders 3 Moto's. Last placed rider will be dropped , then remaining (8 or less) will transfer to 3 finals, points over

SUPERTOUR RACE FORMAT: 3 moto, 3 final format

10 or more riders 3 Motos, Riders are split evenly to A and B Finals i.e. out of 10 riders 5 move to A Final, 5 move to B Final, points over the 3 finals for day position.

Uneven number of riders greater number to A Final lesser to B finals

9 or less riders 3 Moto's. Last placed rider will be dropped , then remaining (8 or less) will transfer to 3 finals, points over

LANE DRAW: Random lane selection per BEM race system for all motos. Finals will be as per the UCI ANNEX 2 - Starting Positions.

MIN CLASS SIZE: 4 riders constitute a class.

TIEBREAKER: At event or end of the series winner will be decided by countback.

PRIZE PURSE: Rider proportional purse. WRSCS Purse spread across top 8 in A final SUPERTOUR Purse to be spread across A & B finals. No trophies or presentation plates.
